Griffiths: 1855, Townland Callowbrack (Buckagh meaning "soft field"): Thomas Mulchrone, No.11 (24 acres, 0 roods, 19 perches). No.14 -Thomas & 6 others leased 123 acres, 2 roods, 31 perches from Sir Richard A. O'Donnell.

Land Holdings: 1883, Holding No.11 and 14 was shared with son Edward Mulchrone. 1886 -Thomas replaced by John Gannon. 1887- Edward became sole landholder.

Name Origin:: Records in Burrishoole Abbey Indicate that in the 16th century the families of HY MAINE of E. Galway settled in Mayo. Among them was an O'Maulcroin.

Property: Early 1900's Tom's sons, Anthony, Edward and John leased land No. 20 (22 arces, 0 roods, 8 perches) from the Irish Land Commision.
